NOTICE of RACE

2019 KANEOHE YACHT CLUB CLASS BOAT SEASON

- 1. RULES:** The 2019 Class Boat Series will be governed by the current year Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) with US Sailing prescriptions, excluding the prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2 and 63.4; and the 2019 Kaneohe Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions (available at KYC). Kaneohe Yacht Club is the organizing authority.
- 2. CLASSES:** Cal 20, I-14, Soling, and Laser provided that three or more boats of a class come to the starting area that day. Other classes may be added by prior arrangement with the Regatta Chair.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRIES:**
 - 3.1** Boats owned or chartered by a KYC member or another Hawaii Yacht Racing Association club.
 - 3.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form and submitting it to KYC prior to the first race sailed. Only one entry is required for the season unless there is a change of ownership.
 - 3.3** If not the owner, the person in charge for each race must be a member of a club affiliated with HYRA or by prior arrangement, a member of another club recognized by US Sailing or ISAF.
- 4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:**
 - 4.1** The 2019 Series dates are: February 9 (A), March 3 (B), March 24 (C), April 14 (D) Wahine Invitational for Cal 20s, May 11 (E), June 2 (F), June 30 (G), July 13 (H), August 11 (I), August 25 (J), November 10 (K).
 - 4.2** The Warning Signal will be at 1155 each day for the first class to start race 1. Races 2 and 3 will be started shortly after the last finisher in the prior race. A 4th race will be held for the Cal 20 fleet.
- 5. COURSES:** The racing area will be on Kaneohe Bay east of Moko O Lo'e (Coconut Island) with courses indicated in the manner described in the 2019 KYC Standing Instructions.
- 6. SCORING:** Each Series will be scored in accord with RSS Appendix A except that no race will be excluded. This modifies Rule A2.
- 7. PRIZES:** Each fleet is responsible for the prizes in that class, if any, unless otherwise announced.
