



NOTICE OF RACE
ORF Short Handed
Saturday, July 22, 2017

1. **RULES:** The regatta shall be governed by the 2017 - 2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), US Sailing prescriptions and the KYC Standing Sailing Instructions.
2. **ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY and FEES:** The races are open to all sailboats owned or chartered by members of Kaneohe Yacht Club with a maximum of two persons aboard. Boats of other organizations may be invited by fleet members. Eligible boats may enter by emailing intent to enter to Frederic Berg at 808.284.4221@earthlink.net with boat name, skipper name, boat type, rating and length. There is no entry fee.
3. **CLASSES:**
 - 3.1. Single Handed Class (no spinnaker; auto pilot allowed)
 - 3.2. Double Handed Class
 - 3.3. Cruising Class (if requested).
4. **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**
 - 4.1. Max Two persons on board.
 - 4.2. Monitor VHF channel 68 throughout the race
 - 4.3. GPS navigation required
 - 4.4. Do not navigate between buoys in a mooring cluster
5. **SCHEDULE of EVENTS:**
 - 5.1. Skippers' Meeting: 8:00 am In front of the KYC bar
 - 5.2. Starting Time: 10:00 am
6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The KYC Standing Sailing Instructions shall be used and are available at the Kaneohe Yacht Club or on the KYC website: www.kaneoheyachtclub.com.
7. **VENUE** The racing shall take place in and around Kaneohe Bay.
8. **COURSE:**
 - 8.1. Course 1: Start with Sampan Channel "G 5" to starboard aligned with Crash boat Channel "G-3"; leave "R-2" to starboard round 60 meter mooring cluster "A" to port; enter Sampan Channel leaving "R-2" to port; round Sampan Channel "G-5" to starboard; REPEAT COURSE; finish at Sampan Channel "G 5" aligned with Crash boat Channel "G-3".
 - 8.2. Course 2: Start with Sampan Channel "G 5" to starboard aligned with Crash boat Channel "G-3"; leave "R-2" to starboard; head upwind until Mokolua Rock (trades near 90° True North) (Alt. 1: Rabbit Island {trades near 60° True North; Alt. 2: Mokulua Island {trades near 75° True North) is visible past Mokapu Peninsula and turn to port, enter Sampan Channel leaving "R-2" to port; round Sampan Channel "G-5" to starboard; finish with Sampan Channel "G-5" to port aligned with Crash boat Channel "G-3". Alternates selected 10 minutes prior to start.

8.3. Skippers to take their own finish times and report to Frederic Berg at 808.284.4221@earthlink.net or text at 808.284.4222. If texting, include your name and vessel name. No verbal or napkin finish times will be accepted.

8.4. Course to be decided at skipper's meeting, based on consensus.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 shall be in effect and modified to require only one turn.

10. SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4.1 shall apply.

11. PRIZES: The honor of racing a yacht short handed is an honor to be cherished. No other prizes will be awarded so as to not diminish this honor. Race results, if available, will be announced after the race at the KYC piano bar area or by email.
