NOTICE OF RACE
2017 JOE COCHRAN MEMORIAL CHANNEL RACE
August 5, 2017

1. RULES: This race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the US SAILING prescriptions, and the KYC Standing Sailing Instructions (available at KYC) except as modified by the Notice of Race. KYC is the organizing authority.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRIES:

2.1 Boats of all types more than 12 feet in overall length may enter at time of registration.

2.2 All entries shall be owned or chartered by a member of KYC, or a Hawaii Yacht Racing Association affiliated organization. If not the owner, the person in charge (skipper) must be a current member of a sailing organization recognized by US Sailing.

3. FEES: No fees are required.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

1100-1130 Registration in the Ma Schultz Lounge

1130 Skippers' Meeting in the Ma Schultz Lounge

1230 First Start takes off from the Bulkhead

Post Racing Celebration, all KYC members welcome to join

5. VENUE: The racing area will be Kaneohe Bay.

6. COURSE:

6.1 The start will be on the bulkhead at Kaneohe Yacht Club, the same as the weekly Thursday night start. Proceed out of the KYC south channel. Proceed west out to the main ship Channel rounding G-7 to port. Pass A mark to starboard while scattering

flowers at A mark, proceed to the south channel at KYC and finish between the end of E pier and the reef marker straight off the end of G pier just as a Thursday night finish would be. Observe all federal aids to navigation and restricted areas.

- 6.2** In the event of light air, substitute an inflatable orange mark in the channel near He'eia for G-7. Round it to port. This course modification will be signaled by hoisting code flag Sierra (blue square on white background) on the KYC flagpole prior to the first start.
- 7. SCORING:** The Joe Cochran Memorial Channel Race will be scored using PHRF handicaps where available, otherwise an appropriate rating will be assigned
- 8. TIME LIMIT:** If no boat has finished within four hours of the first start, the race shall be permanently abandoned.
- 9. RESCHEDULING:** In the event of a cancellation or abandonment, the race shall not be rescheduled for 2017.
- 10. PRIZES:** Awards Ceremony and Celebration will begin sometime after 1600. The overall winner will be awarded the Joe Cochran Memorial Channel Race perpetual trophy. Other prizes will be awarded at the discretion of Cochran Family and Race Committee.
