**NOTICE OF RACE  
ORF Waimea Races**

**August 19 & 20, 2017**

**1. RULES:** The races shall be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including the US SAILING prescriptions, the Sailing Instructions (available at KYC), and this Notice of Race. All boats shall be scored using KYC PHRF.

**2. CLASSES:** There shall be one General Class and may be others such as short handed, spinnaker, non-spinnaker, as may be necessary to increase participation.

**3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRIES:** The races are open to all sailboats owned or chartered by members of Kaneohe Yacht Club. Other boats may request an invitation by the fleet captain. Eligible boats may enter by emailing entry to Frederic Berg at [808.284.4221@earthlink.net](mailto:808.284.4221@earthlink.net) with boat name, skipper name, boat type and length. There is no entry fee. All Melges 24s with a member from a HYRA member Yacht Club as the person in charge are eligible. By way of this Notice, members of Makani Kai Yacht Club and Kokokahi Sailing Club are invited by the fleet captain and are eligible to race.

**4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:**

8/16/11 10:00 am      Start, Kaneohe Bay to Waimea Bay

8/17/11 9:00 am      Start, Waimea Bay to Kaneohe Bay

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The KYC Standing Sailing Instructions shall be used and are available at the Kaneohe Yacht Club or on the KYC website: [www.kaneoheyachtclub.com](http://www.kaneoheyachtclub.com).

**6. COURSES:** The racing area is Windward Oahu from Kaneohe to Waimea Bay.

Saturday August 19<sup>th</sup> Start between Kaneohe Yacht Club race marker “C” buoy and Main Ship Channel Red Nun Buoy R26. There may not be a Race Committee Boat. Start time will be synchronized with cell phone time. Proceed down main ship channel observing all aids to navigation. Round Main Ship Channel “K” Buoy to port. Proceed to finish line at Waimea Bay. Finish on an imaginary line starting at the telephone pole at the top of the hill behind the church tower extending through the church tower and ending .25 mi. off shore. Take your own time. Report your finish time via text to 808.284.4221 or via email at 808.284.4221@earthlink.net. Most of the fleet will anchor in Waimea Bay. If you plan to go to Haleiwa please make mooring/haulout arrangements with harbor master in advance.

Sunday August 20<sup>th</sup> Start line is an imaginary line starting at the telephone pole at the top of the hill behind the church tower extending through the church tower and ending .25 mi. off shore. Proceed to Kaneohe Bay, round main ship channel “K” buoy to starboard, proceed to down main ship channel observing all aids to navigation. Finish between Kaneohe Yacht Club race marker “C” buoy and Red Nun Buoy R26. Take your finish time. Report your finish time via text to 808.284.4221 or via email at [808.284.4221@earthlink.net](mailto:808.284.4221@earthlink.net).

**7. PENALTY SYSTEM:** Rule 44.1 shall be in effect and modified to require only one turn.

**8. SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4.1 shall apply.

**9. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS:** Notices to registered competitors will be sent via email.
